

Women's Bowhunter Novice ... Class for men and Class for Women

- Speed 300 fps 3% margin of error ... if our Chronograph displays an arrow speed of 310 fps, you will be disqualified. (Note you may adjust your speed down prior to tournament. If you are checked during or after the tournament and your bow is 310 fps or greater, you are disqualified from the competition.
- You must shoot in a group of three to five shooters for your score to be legitimate. It is up to the individual archer to ensure this; it is the club's responsibility to tell you the rules.
- No magnification
- Any sight up to a 5-pin limit
- Must be locked down and verified by group. ... No moving of sight or pins at all for the whole tournament once the archer has entered the course to shoot his/her first arrow
- One straight stabilizer, Total length of stabilizer cannot exceed 12 inches as measured from the point of contact with the riser including weights and quick disconnects.
- This is a Known Yardage class, archer may use a range finding device, however no discussion of distances among archers as someone shooting unknown yards may hear discussion. 30 yards max.
- Yellow score Card/ Yellow Shooting Stake ... 30 yards max.
