### SC Circuit Buy In Entry Fees, Awards, and Classes:

### 2024 SC Circuit Buy-in Entry Fees, Awards, and Classes:

**NOTE:** All of entry One Time Buy-in Fees are 100% allocated for the money payback based on class participation with the exception of all Cub and Youth classes as they are trophy only.

### SC Circuit One Time Buy - In Fees

- \$50 Money ... Open Pro Money (Unknown yds. combined)
- \$50 Known 50 men, Known 50 Women
- **\$25** All Young Adults, Adults, Seniors, Super Seniors and Master Seniors with the exception of Classes 39, 39F, 40 & 40F.

**\$10** – All Cubs and Youth plus NASP Elementary and NASP Middle School

### Awards and monies will be presented at the End of Year Award Banquet.

### **Participation Requirements & Rules**

SCAA rules and classes apply.

- Each club in the SCAA will host only Two 2 "SC Circuit shoots" and then Keowee Bowmen will host the "SC Circuit Championship" shoot on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- 2. To participate and qualify for the SC Circuit Championship
  - a. a 3D Circuit Championship entry form must be submitted to the initial host club or the SCAA Secretary prior to the start of the shoot (a participant cannot sign up after the shoot and have it count towards the points championship total).
  - b. Each participant must shoot at least one score from one of the two SC Circuit shoots that each club hosts. (highest score is used)
  - c. The participant also shall shoot the SC Circuit Championship shoot at Keowee on July  $20^{th}$  to be eligible for Circuit Championship

**NOTE:** A 3D Circuit membership is not an SCAA membership. In order to be qualified as "The SC State 3D Champion" you must be an SCAA/NFAA Member. In other words, the SC 3D Circuit Champion and the SC 3D State Champion can be two different people

- 3. Scoring for Circuit Championship as follows:
  - a. The highest score from each club
  - b. The added points from the SC State 3D / SC Circuit Championship
  - c. The total of those points will determine each class winner
- 4. The Circuit Champion from each class receives 100% of the One Time Buy-In Fee along with an award as Class Champion. A score board will be kept on the SCAA Website & on Keowee Bowmen's website.
  - a. Competitors shall immediately notify the SCAA 3D Circuit representative for corrections. NOTE: <u>If corrections are not conveyed to the club where score was shot within 7 days;</u> <u>then the scores are as noted on the website</u>. Ties Broken by the number of X's and if still tied at the end of the year the tie will be resolved by a single arrow shoot-off between the competitors until a champion is determined.
- 5. A SC Circuit competitor may only participate in one class for the Circuit Championship. The class shall be identified on the SC Circuit registration/ membership card. The competitor may shoot another class during any club tournament but the score in the other class will not count towards the Circuit Championship point's total.
- 6. SCAA has a speed rule of a maximum of 300 fps with a 3% variance with the exception of the "Known 40 Outlaw" class. All 3D Circuit Championship shooters must be prepared to shoot through a chronograph. A

disqualification of tournament score will result if a competitor shoots over the maximum speed after beginning the tournament. (Excludes Known 40 Outlaw.)

- 7. It is the SC Circuit competitor's job to ensure he/she shoots in a group with at least 3 adults. These adults do not need to be 3D circuit competitors. SCAA defines an adult as a competitor that is 18 years old or older. Clubs may make exceptions to this rule on a case-by-case basis due to limited number of shooters.
- Club Circuit Tournaments will be casual registration and an exclusive weekend tournament (Upstate or Lower state) for the hosting club. However, the final 3D Championship tournament will be a shotgun start at 9AM on July 20<sup>th</sup> at Keowee Bowmen range.
- 9. Tournaments are open to any registered archer. Circuit and non-circuit archers will compete in the same class as registered

Move Up Rule for Men's Pins/30 yd max- (This rule does not apply to the Women's Pins 30)

• The past State 3D, 3D Circuit, Regional, OR SOY champions in the Men's Pins 30 yd. class (formerly known as Bowhunter Novice) shall move up to a higher class for at least two years; i.e., Men's Open 40 (Unknown), Men's known 40, etc.
